Members developed Operating Protocols (see attached) and expect to complete them at the next meeting.

Members and Guests brainstormed the desired purposes for the Stewardship Committee (see attached). Members summarized their purpose as dealing with “the whole park and all issues in the park; North Clackamas Park as a whole and as it impacts outside the borders of the park.”

Construction update: Dan Zinzer reported that the County expects to open bids May 3, and to issue contracts by the end of May. Construction would begin in June, and grass would be planted September 1. Park should be ready for ball games in May 2007. He anticipates that planning for the North side would begin in 2007.

Members agreed they would like to meet on a monthly basis, once they have completed work on setting up their initial structure and operating protocols, and to meet more often in the beginning in order to complete that task.
